December 30, 2020 – Jupiter, Fla. – Come explore life on the waterfront with your family - in a socially-distant, new fun way on Saturday, Jan. 16 at the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum. This year's Family Adventure Day has been reimagined, offering families the chance to visit the Lighthouse grounds using activities provided to 'create your own' adventure!

Upon entrance, children will receive a Youth Explorer Goodie Bag to begin their fun & discovery. Included in your kit is a pair of Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse binoculars to spy all the great history and nature! Your kit also contains coloring page, Lighthouse pencil, a ship-making kit and a special History Mystery Scavenger Hunt. Just follow the clues and instructions to complete your hunt. Now you're ready to create your own Lighthouse adventure!

Families will be able to visit the Museum, Lighthouse, Tindall Pioneer Homestead, Keeper's Workshop, and historic grounds with special photo spots. Families can also discover the nature trail tours and Jr. Park Ranger Booklets & crayons provided by the Bureau of Land Management.

Please bring sunscreen & dress for the weather! Program attendees are also invited to climb the Lighthouse: children must be a minimum of 48" tall to climb, be accompanied by an adult. For your safety, masks are required at this event and social distancing should be observed between other individuals or family groups. Pets, food, drink and coolers are not permitted at this event.
