



## Field Trips

The Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum offers **field trips** of the 1860 lighthouse and historic grounds. Outdoor historic grounds exhibits include the Tindall Pioneer Homestead & Gardens, Pennock Plantation Bell, Florida's First Peoples exhibit, Seminole Chickee, Keeper's Workshop and Oil House. The lighthouse is part of the federally designated Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse Outstanding Natural Area.

A maximum of 60 students and 10 chaperones are allowed per visit. A minimum of 15 total for a group rate to apply. There is a limit to how many people can safely climb the lighthouse. Large groups will be split in equal smaller groups. Approximate tour time for guided tour is one hour and fifteen minutes, please allow an additional twenty minutes if you would like to visit the Gift Shop.

### **CHAPERONES ARE REQUIRED TO CLIMB THE LIGHTHOUSE**

**Failure to provide required chaperones will result in the group not climbing the lighthouse.**

**Children under the height requirement (48 inches) will not be permitted to climb the tower.**

**1 chaperone per 10 students/campers REQUIRED.**

**1 chaperone per 5 non-climbers required in addition to the climbing groups**

### **RATES:**

Final headcount is required **one week prior** to the visit date.

**School Field Trips** \$4 per student, teacher & chaperone

**Title 1 School** FREE, 4<sup>th</sup> grade level & above only

**Camps & Scouts** \$5 per child & \$11 per adult

*(Each group of 15 must include 3 adult chaperones)*

## Things to Know Before You Visit

**Check-in:** Group leaders enter the gift shop upon arrival to provide payment. Payment must cover the entire group (no individual payments) and is accepted in cash, card or checks made payable to *Loxahatchee River Historical Society*.

**Parking:** School bus and motor coach parking is available and grounds are ADA compliant.

**Prohibited on Lighthouse Grounds:** Large purses or book bags, smoking, food & drink, chewing gum, pets, selfie sticks, tripods and drones. \*Teachers may bring a bookbag for student medical supplies.

**Museum will be closed for an extended period beginning Nov. 29, 2021.**

**Behavior Standards:** Students are not permitted any exhibits, trees, railings or structures, nor not touch artifacts in the exhibits unless instructed by Museum Staff.

**Restroom Availability:** There are three restrooms at the admissions & gift shop facility and **NO** restrooms on the lighthouse grounds.

**Lighthouse Gift Shop:** Student groups are not allowed in the store without adult supervision. If students would like to shop in the store, please divide them into groups of 5 at a time.

**Lunch/ Food:** The Lighthouse and Museum does not offer any food service nor are water there fountains. Please bring water or water may be purchased in the gift shop for \$2. Field Trips and Camps are welcome to bring lunch to eat on the lawn in front of the museum (there are no picnic tables available & area may be closed off due to bridge construction).

**Weather:** The historic site will shut down in the case of rain, lightning, thunder or high winds for visitor safety. Tours may resume 30 minutes after, leaving time for sidewalks and steps to dry. There is no penalty for cancelling or rescheduling a tour due to weather.

From I-95, exit at Indiantown Road East. Follow Indiantown Road east to US Highway 1.

Turn north (left) onto US Highway 1 and continue to Alt A1A/ Beach Road.

Turn east (right) onto A1A / Beach Road.

Immediately turn right onto Captain Armour's Way into Lighthouse Park.

Follow the road past the soccer fields to the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum.
