



Things to Know

The number of individuals that can be on a tour is limited. We allow a maximum of 60 students on every school tour and require a minimum of 15 for the group rate to apply. Due to the small number of people that can safely climb the lighthouse, large groups will be split in equal parts.

CHAPERONES MUST BE ABLE TO CLIMB THE LIGHTHOUSE WITH THE STUDENTS

We require that at least 3 chaperones accompany each group on the tour and while climbing the tower. If any teachers are unable to climb the tower, other chaperones must accompany the group.

Group Rates: *Prices are per person*

School Field Trips \$4 per student and \$4 per chaperone or teacher

Title 1 Schools FREE, 4th grade and above only

Camps & Scouts \$5 per child and \$11 per adults (*Each group of 15 must include 3 adult chaperones*)

Adults & Seniors \$11 per adult and \$10 per senior (*Age 60 and up*)

Lighthouse and Museum Rules

- **All children must be at least 48" tall to climb tower.** Adults may not carry children up or down the Lighthouse.
- **The following are prohibited on Lighthouse Grounds:** large purses or book bags of any kind, smoking, food & drink, chewing gum, pets, selfie sticks, tripods and drones. Visitors may bring a camera without a bag. Lighthouse Tours are approximately 60 minutes long, weather permitting.
- **The following are prohibited inside the Museum:** Photography, pets, food & drink, chewing gum, and smoking. **Museum is self-guiding.**
- School bus and motor coach parking is available and grounds are ADA compliant.
- Lighthouse climbers are required to wear proper footwear (**no high heels**).

Check-in

All groups must check in at the Gift Shop to receive instructions. This is also your opportunity to complete payment if you have not already done so. Payment must cover the entire group (no individual payments) and is accepted cash, card or checks made payable to *Loxahatchee River Historical Society*.

Restroom Availability

There are a limited number of restrooms available at the Museum and no restrooms on the lighthouse grounds.

Lunch/ Food

The Lighthouse and Museum does not offer any food options nor do we have water fountains. Please bring water or water may be purchased in the gift shop for \$2. Field Trips and Camps are welcome to bring lunch to eat on the lawn in front of the museum.

Museum Store

Student groups are not allowed in the store without adult supervision. If your students would like to shop in the store please be sure to break them into groups of no more than 5 at a time.

Weather

Tours are weather permitting. The historic site will shut down in the case of rain, lightening, thunder or high winds. Tours may resume 30 minutes after, leaving time for sidewalks and steps to dry. There is no penalty for cancelling or rescheduling a tour due to weather.
