Celebrate National Lighthouse Day on August 7th at the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum

Public invited to enjoy 2-for-1 tours and climbs throughout the day and become inaugural members of newly-launched 'Lighthouse Luminary' social club

August 2, 2018 - Jupiter, Fla.— The Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum invites the community to a day-long celebration of its iconic Palm Beach County landmark destination on Tuesday, August 7th – to recognize National Lighthouse Day. From 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. visitors are invited to take advantage of 2-for-1 tours, climbs and grounds exhibits. With the purchase of one adult or senior ticket entrance fee (\$12/\$10), a second, accompanying visitor can also enjoy, at no added charge, the chance to explore 5,000 years of Florida history on its 120-acres of lush, waterside grounds, at the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum, 500 Captain Armour's Way, in Jupiter.

"We're so proud to represent our community locally on National Lighthouse Day, especially since we are still an active Aid-to-Navigation and one of the most iconic visitor destinations in Palm Beach County," said Jamie Stuve, President and Chief Executive Officer of the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum. "We invite lighthouse fans everywhere to come celebrate our treasured 1860 Lighthouse and all the spectacular beacons shining along America's coastlines."

Lighthouse Day also marks the launch of the nonprofit's new "Lighthouse Luminary" social club that offers "Luminaries" special invitations and perks like VIP social events, Sunset Tours, and more! "Luminaries" was created as an active social group to bring people together who are passionate ambassadors of preservation, to grow and protect the heritage site. Points of interest to enjoy while at the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum include a climb to the top of its landmark 1860 lighthouse, learning more about the lighthouse in the *Keeping the Light at Jupiter Inlet* exhibit, a walk through the 1892 Tindall Pioneer Homestead, a rest on the deck underneath a beautiful banyan canopy, and visits to its museum and gift shop. A host of events is held ongoing and throughout the year, to invite visitors to experience the historic, serene setting of the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum. Some include Twilight Yoga at the Light, Sunset and Moonrise Tours, Lighthouse Story Time & Crafts for Kids, Lighthouse Book Club and Hike Through History. Now, visitors can “Tour Your Way” with the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum’s signature mobile app. Guided, docent tours are available daily.

Coming up in 2018-19 – Season of Light:

September:

Love Our Locals Wednesdays – Palm Beach and Martin County adult residents (Age 19+) are admitted FREE with ID, every Wednesday in September – Regular daytime admission.

November:

U.S. Veterans are admitted FREE in November – Regular daytime admission with U.S. Veterans ID.

Year-round:

Blue Star Museum – Active Duty U.S. Military and immediate family members admitted FREE during regular daytime admission – Must show valid U.S. Military ID.

About National Lighthouse Day:

On August 7, 1789, the United States Congress approved an act for the “establishment and support of Lighthouse, Beacons, Buoys, and Public Piers.” It was two hundred years later that Congress designated August 7th as National Lighthouse Day.
