Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum
cancels group tours, Museum and Lighthouse remain open for self-guided tours

March 13, 2020 – Jupiter, Fla. – The Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum is closely monitoring the information disseminated by the Federal government, state, Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Palm Beach County Health Department and implementing all safety standards for additional cleaning, sanitization and will be adjusting their hours of operations accordingly due to the COVID-19 virus. Our top priority is the health and safety of the staff, volunteers, and visitors. Beginning today all school and group tours, sunset, and guided tours are canceled. In addition, we will be closed on Mondays as we implement our summer hours. The Jupiter Lighthouse & Museum will remain open Tuesday – Sunday, with regular hours of operation 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. for self-guided tours. Last grounds admission is 4 p.m.
